

GREENWAY ETIQUETTE


- All Town of Apex greenways are considered multi-use. Bicyclists & skaters should always yield to pedestrians.
- When using greenways in groups, please stay to the right of the trail & do not block the greenway.
- When approaching from behind, pass on the left & give a mechanical or verbal warning such as "PASSING ON THE LEFT."
- Greenway users are encouraged to have a companion with them whenever possible.
- A 10MPH speed limit applies to all public parks and greenways

WHILE NOT EXPRESSLY LISTED ABOVE, PARK RULES & REGULATIONS, IN SECTION 15-7, TOWN OF APEX CODE OF ORDINANCES APPLY TO BOTH PUBLIC PARKS & GREENWAYS.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

PUBLIC GREENWAYS & TRAILS

Greenways and trails open at sunrise and close 30 minutes after sunset unless closed for maintenance or emergency. Motorized vehicles of any type, except those related to Public Safety and Maintenance, are prohibited. Horses are prohibited on public greenways and trails within the Town of Apex's corporate limits. Horses are, however, permitted on the American Tobacco Trail.

BOATING AT COMMUNITY PARK

A Town of Apex seasonal permit is required to launch vessels on the Apex Community Park Lake. All permits expire on December 31st of the year purchased. Permits must be affixed to your vessel and visible at all times. Vessels are defined as canoes, kayaks, paddle boards, sailboards and john boats. No other vessels are permitted. Vessel length may not exceed 14ft. Inflatables are prohibited. Battery powered trolling motors are the only authorized power source for vessels. Only car-topped vessels are permitted. Vessels must be carried by hand from the parking lot to the launch site as driving on the greenway trails is prohibited by Town ordinance. A USCG approved lifejacket must be worn by each occupant of each vessel at all times while launching and while on the lake.

Resident Fees: \$5 / vessel
 Non-Resident Fees: \$40 / vessel.

FISHING

A Town of Apex Fishing Permit is required to fish at Apex Community Park, Seagroves Farm Park, and Salem Pond Park. Permits are free for Apex residents. Prices for non-residents vary depending on age. One day guest passes may be purchased by anyone for a \$5 fee. Fishing licenses are annual, valid 12 months from the date issued. You will receive a photo ID card when you apply. Fishing is only permitted during posted hours.

Anglers age 16+ must also hold a State of North Carolina Fishing License and abide by all regulations regarding keel limits as established by the NCWC. Call 888-248-6843 or visit (www.ncwildlife.org/licenses).

FACILITY RENTALS & NON-DEPARTMENT USE

Some facilities and areas managed by the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Resources Department are available for rental when not in use for programs and activities organized by APRCR. Non-departmental use and rental of Town facilities is governed by various policies, rules and regulations. Shelter reservation requests may be completed online via Peak Connect while all other rentals require in person rental. In-person rentals are only accepted between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the John M. Brown Community Center between 9:00am-4:00pm at the Senior Center and between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at the Halle Cultural Arts Center.

DOG PARKS

The Town of Apex manages two dog parks located at Apex Nature Park and Hunter Street Park. Both Dog Parks are gated and require pass cards for use. One key card is distributed upon initial registration. Additional key cards can be purchased for \$10/card. Passes are available for purchase at the John M. Brown Community Center for both single dog and multiple dogs. There is a 2-dog limit per application and fees are based on residency:

Single dog (per year): \$30 for resident / \$60 for nonresident. Multiple dogs (per year): \$50 for resident / \$100 for nonresident.

Proof of vaccination is required at the time of application. Dogs must have collar with ID, and display rabies vaccination tags at all times while in the Park. Dogs younger than 6 months old are prohibited.

PETS IN PARKS

Pets must be leashed at all times and are not permitted on, or within, any athletic field, on any athletic playing surface or within any playground. Per the Town of Apex's animal sanitation rules, dog owners must carry a bag or other container suitable for removing feces and same shall be removed immediately after it is deposited by the dog. "Service Animals" are permitted in accordance with State and Federal Guidelines.
